## THE SCHOOL

Founded in 2014, William & Reed Academy's mission is to inspire students to learn and exceed expectations, while preparing for the college of their choice in a flexible and unique small-class educational setting. William & Reed Academy currently serves students in grades 6–12.

William & Reed Academy has developed a blended learning model which features a concentrated school week. Students attend class Monday through Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., with an optional online/flex period component that ends daily at 2:00 p.m. and an optional face-to-face Spanish class that ends at 3:00 p.m. William & Reed's schedule maximizes academic instructional time by offering core academic classes in a shorter school day blended with online electives. This schedule allows for students to have more freedom to explore extracurricular activities which allows for them to shine holistically once they graduate and explore their post-secondary endeavors.

### ACCREDITATION

William & Reed Academy is duly accredited ("Accredited with Quality") as a private school through both the Georgia Accrediting Commission (GAC) and Cognia and is thus recognized by the Georgia Department of Education and the University System of Georgia Board of Regents.

### CLASS RANK

Due to the small size of William & Reed Academy's student body, William & Reed does not report class rank. Although William & Reed does not report class rank, GPA is the determining factor when selecting the valedictorian and salutatorian of each graduating class. The GPA calculation in determining these honors is based on all high school level coursework. Additionally, a student must have attended W&R for two full academic school years in order to qualify for these distinctions. Small differences in GPA could result in significant differences with regards to student ranking or percentile; therefore, W&R believes that class rank is a biased statistic. William & Reed also wishes to discourage unhealthy competition amongst students based on grades.

W&R admits academically qualified students without regard to race, creed, color, sex, or national and ethnic origin.

William & Reed Academy's total enrollment for the 2023-2024 school year was 143 students. W&R's high school enrollment for 2024-2025 is:

#### **GRADING SYSTEM**

- The cumulative GPA is the numerical average of all high school course credits.
- Honors level courses are given an additional weight of 0.5 on a 4.0 scale. For example, a grade of an 83% in an honors level course will be weighted as a 3.5 on a student's transcript.
- Advanced Placement courses are given an additional weight of 1.0 on a 4.0 scale. For example, a grade of an 83% in an Advanced Placement course will be weighted as a 4.0 on a student's transcript.

#### THE CURRICULUM AND OFFERINGS

William & Reed Academy offers small classes in all core subject areas (math, science, social studies, language arts and world languages), as well as various online electives. All high school level academic courses have an honors option. W&R currently offers seven face-to-face Advanced Placement courses - AP English Language & Composition, AP Literature & Composition, AP Environmental Science , AP Calculus AB, AP Statistics, AP US History, and AP Government. In 2023-2024, AP Psychology and AP Physics 1 were also offered face-to-face. In addition, there are 5 Advanced Placement courses available through our fully accredited (Cognia) online vendor, Pearson Connexus. All of William & Reed Academy's academic courses are NCAA Approved.

#### MINIMESTER

William & Reed Academy has developed a four-week Minimester program that begins during the last two weeks of school in December and concludes during the first two weeks of school in January. During Minimester each student takes one or two elective courses, earning 0.5 elective credits. Many courses provide our students with project-based learning and community service opportunities. Courses typically offered during Minimester are:

- <u>6th Grade</u>: Financial Literacy, Creative Writing, Public Speaking, Study Skills
- <u>7th Grade</u>: Entrepreneurship, Brain Games
- <u>8th Grade</u>: Acting, Film Production
- <u>9th Grade</u>: Health

- <u>10th Grade</u>: Driver's Ed, Digital Photography, Creative Writing, Leadership
- <u>11th Grade</u>: ACT Prep & College Research
- <u>12th Grade</u>: Senior Service/Community Outreach

The Class of 2024, comprised of 23 students, was the ninth graduating class of William & Reed Academy. All 23 seniors in the Class of 2024 graduated (100% graduation rate).
